Passports now needed to cross Mexican and Canadian borders

Starting June 1, Americans who want to cross into the US from either Canada or Mexico must show passports or specially issued identification cards.

Besides passports a federal passport card or enhanced driver's license issued by some states (not California) are acceptable identification.
